War Memorials Trust welcomes the announcement today of government support for the repair and conservation of war memorials. This one-off funding should support the additional demand for works to war memorials stimulated by the centenary of World War I.

War Memorials Trust looks forward to working with DCMS to develop this funding proposal. It is important resources are made available as quickly as possible to help communities ensure their war memorials are in the best possible condition through the duration of the centenary. It is also vital to recognise that projects do not happen overnight but may take time as the most appropriate works need to be identified to safeguard the long-term preservation of these historic monuments, plaques and landscape features.

Frances Moreton, Director, War Memorials Trust said: "The forthcoming centenary of World War I has already seen the charity make record numbers of grant offers and deal with a huge volume of enquiries. Those who donate to our work make that possible and we thank them and encourage them, and others, to continue that support. This new one-off funding will enable the charity to meet additional demands generated by centenary interest."

War Memorials Trust supports war memorials of all types and dates. It is currently encouraging people across the UK to support War Memorials Online, www.warmemorialsonline.org.uk. This project seeks to create a greater understanding of the condition of war memorials by asking the public to upload information. Anyone can register and get involved to share photos, data and condition details as well as reporting any concerns. From the information gathered the new resources can be used to target those memorials in greatest need.
